The 3 hour BEST course is a required course to renew your CCB License. This course meets the Oregon Construction Contractors Board's continuing education requirements.— **3 Core Credit Hours**

The course incorporates the relevant code and product requirements for an Exterior Wall Envelope as defined in Oregon Residential Specialty Code R703.1.
